General situation and animal information: An injured calf was reported on May 18 and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: Bite wounds were found on the upper hindquarters and groin. The size and location of teeth marks was indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were found in the field where the attack occurred.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was injured by wolves.
