General Area: Central Tulare County, Tule River Tribe Reservation, Yowlumni pack area

General situation and animal information: A deceased heifer was found by Tule River Tribe Staff on June 5th and investigated the same day by CDFW staff.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: none, no subcutaneous hemorrhaging observed, no struggle/kill scene.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: A single set of wolf tracks were observed near the scene. BOY03F collar data indicated presence near the scene on June 2 for less than four hours.

Summary: Advanced stages of scavenging prevented a thorough investigation. Bear and wild pig scat were observed at the carcass.
