- Develop a list of kelp-focused interested entities (i.e., non-governmental organizations, private companies, communities) across California that can strengthen the state's understanding of existing networks and connections in the coastal kelp sphere.

Draft recommendations that do not meet Charter criteria will be revised or tabled for future consideration.
