Background

This is a standing agenda item for staff and the Department to request changes to the Commission's rulemaking timetable (Exhibit 3), confirm changes made by the Commission during this meeting, and highlight minor changes made by staff.

The Department requests eight changes to the rulemaking timetable (exhibits 1 and 2):

- Update the adoption date for the "White Sturgeon Sport Fishing 2084" rulemaking to August 2025.
- Remove the "Big Game Preference Points" rulemaking, amending Section 708. This rulemaking is not necessary at this time, according to Department program staff.
- Schedule the annual "Waterfowl Hunting" rulemaking, amending Section 502, for notice in December 2025, discussion in February 2026, and adoption in April 2026. Potential waterfowl hunting regulation changes will be discussed at the September 2025 Wildlife Resources Committee (WRC) meeting, with Commission approval at this meeting.
- Add a "Big Game Hunting, 2026-2027 Seasons" rulemaking to amend sections 362, 363, 364, and potentially other sections. This rulemaking is necessary to make adjustments to regulations for big game hunting, such as hunt tag quotas, hunt zone areas, and season dates. The proposed rulemaking schedule is notice in December 2025, discussion in February 2026, and adoption in April 2026. Potential big game hunting regulation changes will be discussed at the September 2025 WRC meeting, with Commission approval at this meeting.
- Add a "Black Bear Hunting" rulemaking to amend Section 365. This rulemaking is
 necessary to maintain appropriate bear harvest rates and hunt quality and opportunities.
 The proposed rulemaking schedule is for notice in December 2025, discussion in
 February 2026, and adoption in April 2026. Potential black bear hunting regulation
 changes will be discussed at the September 2025 WRC meeting, with Commission
 approval at this meeting.
- Add an "Inland Sport Fishing 2026" rulemaking, amending multiple sections to be determined. This rulemaking is necessary to make periodic adjustments to inland fishing regulations throughout the state, such as increased fishing opportunities, allowable gear, seasonal species protection, biological sampling, and report card requirements.

Staff Summary for August 13-14, 2025

The proposed rulemaking schedule before the full Commission has not yet been determined; however, initial vetting of potential regulation changes is recommended at the September 2025 WRC meeting, with additional discussion and potential recommendations at the January 2026 WRC meeting.

- Add a "Rattlesnake Exhibition" rulemaking, amending sections to be determined. This
 rulemaking is necessary to provide a possession and propagation permitting framework
 for commercial exhibition of California native rattlesnakes. The proposed rulemaking
 schedule before the full Commission has not yet been determined; however, initial
 vetting of potential regulation changes is recommended at the September 2025 WRC
 meeting, with additional discussion and potential recommendations at the January 2026
 WRC meeting.
- Make various adjustments to anticipated regulation effective dates.

Commission staff requests one change to the rulemaking timetable:

 Reschedule the "Commercial Coonstripe Shrimp Fishery Emergency (Second 90-Day Extension) from adoption in October 2025 to adoption in December 2025.

- 1. Please update the adoption for the existing rulemaking, "White sturgeon sport fishing 2084" to adoption at the upcoming August meeting, and a regulation effective date of effective upon filing.
- 2. Please remove the rulemaking, "Big game preference points" from the rulemaking calendar. Department programs have determined that amendments to regulatory language are not necessary.
- 3. Please update the effective date of the rulemaking, "Golden mussel, green crab, *Sinanondonta* and *Xeonstrobus* Restricted Species" to be effective upon filing no later than December 13, 2025.
- 4. Please add the annual rulemaking, "Waterfowl hunting, 2026-2027 seasons (Annual)" amending Section 502, requesting to authorize notice at the December 2025 meeting, discussion at the February 2026 meeting, and adoption at the April 2026 meeting. This is the standard waterfowl rulemaking that occurs annually as part of the Pacific Flyway Council updates.
- 5. Please add the periodic rulemaking, "Big game hunting, 2026-2027 seasons" amending sections 362, 363, 364, and other sections TBD, requesting to authorize notice at the December 2025 meeting, discussion at the February 2026 meeting, and adoption at the April 2026 meeting. These are annual updates for big game hunting.
- 6. As part of big game hunting, please add an infrequent rulemaking "Black bear hunting" amending section 365, requesting to authorize notice at the December 2025 meeting, discussion at the February 2026 meeting, and adoption at the
