Pursuant to the requirements of California Government Code Section 11346.8, subdivision (c), and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the California Fish and Game Commission (Commission) is providing you with a notice of sufficiently related changes to the proposed regulations concerning Recreational Crab Fishing Gear and Commercial Passenger Fishing Vessel Trap Validation, published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on May 30, 2025, Notice No. Z2025-0520-05.

The Commission is providing notice of revisions to the proposed amendments to the regulatory language in section 29.80 Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR).

Because these regulations are different from, yet sufficiently related to, the originally proposed regulations, the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires that we make these changes available to you for a minimum fifteen-day written comment period.
