NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the provisions of California Fish and Game Code Section 15007, that the California Fish and Game Commission (Commission) is expected to consider an application for an amendment to a restricted species permit. The permit amendment would allow the applicant to import, possess, transport or rear, or conduct research on transgenic painted sea urchin (*Lytechinus pictus*).

The Commission may take action consistent with its regulation in subdivision (a)(8)(H) of Section 671.1, Title 14, California Code of Regulations, related to transgenic aquatic animals, if warranted. Specifically, the Commission may deny the issuance of a permit or permit amendment if it finds that an applicant is or will be unable to meet all regulatory requirements for importation, transportation, possession, and confinement of transgenic aquatic animals.
