NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to the provisions of Fish and Game Code Section 2078, that the California Fish and Game Commission (Commission), has scheduled final consideration of the petition to list Bear Lake buckwheat (*Eriogonum microtheca* var. *lacus-ursi*) as an endangered species for its December 10-11, 2025 meeting. It is expected that consideration of the petition will be heard December 10, 2025 in Sacramento, California.

Consideration of the petition will be heard at the California Natural Resources Headquarters Building, 715 P Street, Sacramento California.
