Background

TC works under Commission direction to set and accomplish its work plan. Today, the Commission will receive a report on the previous TC meeting, provide direction for any referred topics and revisions to TC work plan topics and timing, and consider approving the next TC meeting agenda topics.

Previous Committee Meeting

TC met in Sacramento on December 9, with Zoom and phone options for agency partners and members of the public. Official meeting minutes will be posted on the [Commission's YouTube page](#); a link will also be available on the Commission's meetings page at fgc.ca.gov/meetings.

TC received updates on standing meeting agenda items, including species management plans, committee cross-pollination, staff and other agency actions, Commission rulemakings, and future agenda topics. In addition, TC discussed three topics:

1. *Co-Management Roundtable*. Discussed tribal co-management initiatives and projects planned or underway in collaboration with public agencies and California tribes. Tribal representatives were invited to share their co-management interests and experiences.
2. *Tribal Subsistence Definition*. Discussed the process for developing a tribal subsistence definition and received an initial progress report by the tribal participants.
3. *Commission Tribal Consultation Policy*. Held an initial discussion regarding potential changes to the Commission's *Tribal Consultation Policy* in the context of the new California Natural Resources Agency Tribal Consultation Policy and associated tribal consultation best practices guide.

Committee Work Plan

Topics referred by the Commission to TC are displayed within a work plan to assist with scheduling and tracking (Exhibit 1). Any further proposed changes to the work plan will be presented orally during today's meeting. Given the vacancy in the Commission tribal advisor and liaison position, staff does not recommend adding any new topics to the work plan.
