

# FISHING FOR KOKANEE? LET US KNOW!



We marked 50,000 hatchery Kokanee salmon by removing the adipose fin. They were planted in **Stampede Reservoir** in May, 2025.

We want to know if you are catching them in 2026-2028 to understand the impact of stocking efforts at this water.



Closely inspect the adipose fin area and record "unknown" if unable to confirm fin status. Record the below data in a notebook or your favorite phone application.
