 - CVP: They are in the process of decreasing releases from Keswick at Folsom at 2500 cfs, will stay there for a little bit. Jones is continuing at 3500 cfs. The flows at New Melones may see a small, short duration increase for maintenance activities. DCC Channel gates are closed.
 - SWP: Feather River releases are decreasing from 2500 cfs to 2300 cfs and will continue to decrease down to 1750 cfs later this week. Clifton Court is at 2900 cfs and will stay pretty close to that. We are currently at -5000 OMR. State share of San Luis is 977 TAF.
 - Hydrology Update: Still continuing with dry weather. Nothing in the forecast for additional precipitation.
