  - Operational Updates
    - CVP: Keswick at 6500 cfs, but stepping up to 10,000 cfs Jan on 29 and going down to 7500 cfs on Jan 30 and 31. Nimbus decreased down to 3000 cfs today and will decrease down to 2500 cfs tomorrow. Goodwin is currently at 300 cfs and will increase to 800 cfs. Jones is currently exporting at 3500 cfs and Cross Channel gates are closed. The Federal share of San Luis is 588 TAF.
    - SWP: Feather River releases are at 1750 cfs, Clifton Court is at 2800 cfs and will continue to operate at -5000 OMR. Potential for triggering Port Chicago operations for February. That creates some uncertainty moving forward. The State share of San Luis is 982 TAF. Big Notch opened up today to let around 500 cfs of flow and will maintain this for a while.
    - Hydrology Update: Small amount of rain last night but it wasn't much, and there is nothing in the forecast.
