§ 845.2. Inspections and Monitoring.

(a) The Administrator ~~shall~~ may carry out an inspection program ~~which shall~~ to include the following:

(1) ~~a~~ At least once every three years, ~~the Administrator shall conduct~~ a system safety inspection of ~~each vessel~~ vessels engaged in transfer operations in the marine waters of California. Situations that may prompt an inspection include, but are not limited to, transfer operations that occur at anchor, or when a vessel is calling upon California for the first time. Such an inspection ~~shall~~ will determine whether the vessel is in compliance with equipment, procedures, and other requirements as specified by this subchapter.

(2) ~~m~~ Monitoring transfer operations at the transfer site on a continuing, random basis.

(b) Inspectors' Access to Vessels and Records – *No Change*
