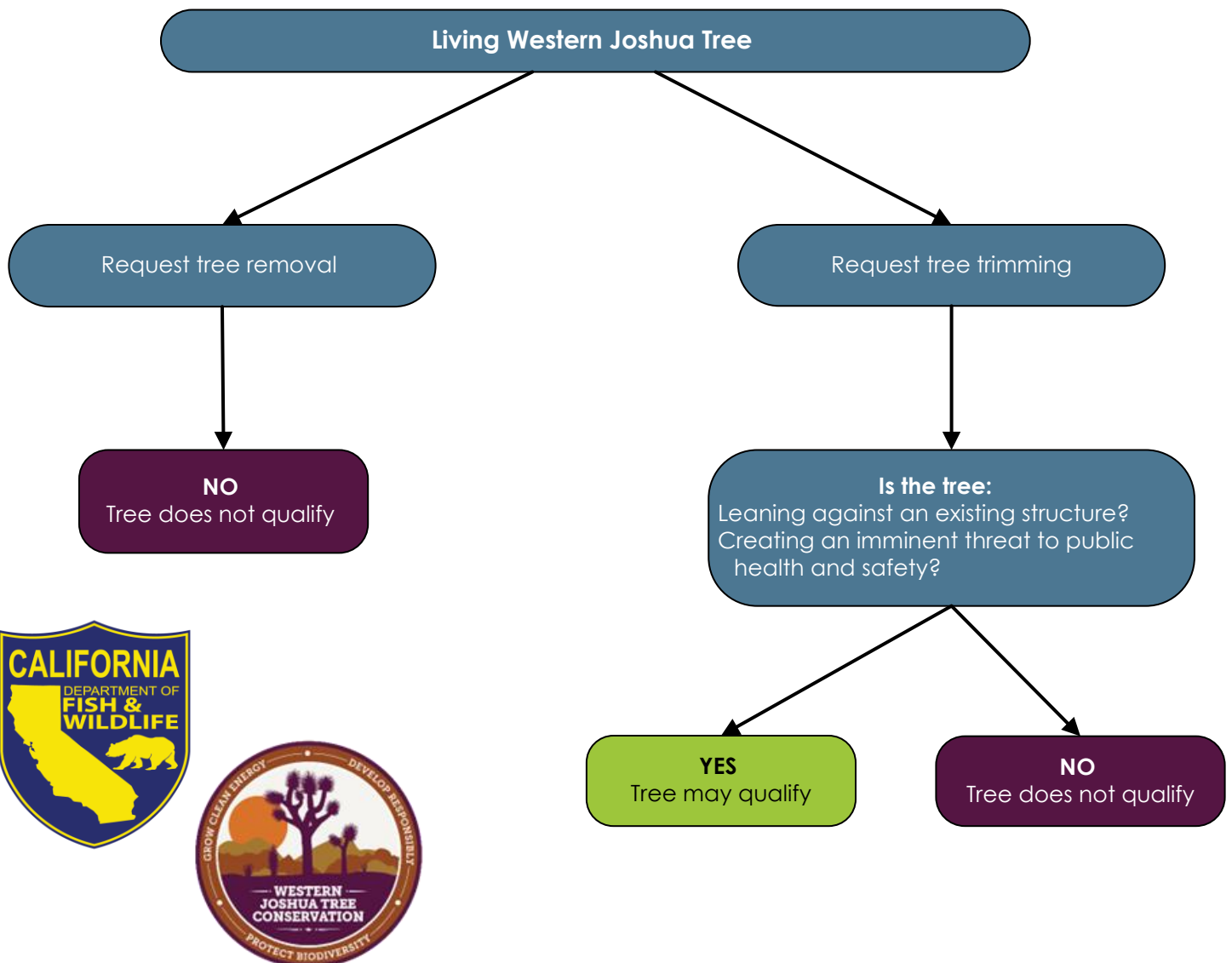


Does my tree qualify for a Western Joshua Tree Conservation Act hazard management permit ?



Please note, trimming of a western Joshua tree must be completed by a Desert Native Plant Specialist (DNPS). A DNPS means an arborist certified by the International Society of Arborists, or an individual with at least five years of professional experience with relocation or restoration of native California desert vegetation.
