Subject: Information requested by the Commission regarding stressors affecting the Bay-Delta Ecosystem and threatened and endangered species that depend on it.

At your March 3, 2010 meeting the Commission received a presentation for the National Marine Fisheries Service requesting that the Commission consider removing bag and size limits on striped bass as a way of minimizing predation on juvenile salmon in the Bay-Delta and its tributaries. As part of the subsequent discussion of the issue the Commission requested that the Department provide technical information regarding the stressors which affect the Bay-Delta Ecosystem and the species, including salmon, which rely upon it for all or part of their life history requirements. As part of the request the Commission requested that we prioritize the stressors and identify the agencies responsible for addressing them. The Department was also requested to provide information about the resources needed resolve the stressors and the timelines involved.

Attached is the requested report, **A REPORT TO THE CALIFORNIA FISH AND GAME COMMISSION ON STRESSORS IMPACTING DELTA RELATED ORGANISMS**. I look forward to working with the Commission to identify ways in which the Commission and Department can work together to address these stressors for the benefit of the Bay-Delta Ecosystem.
