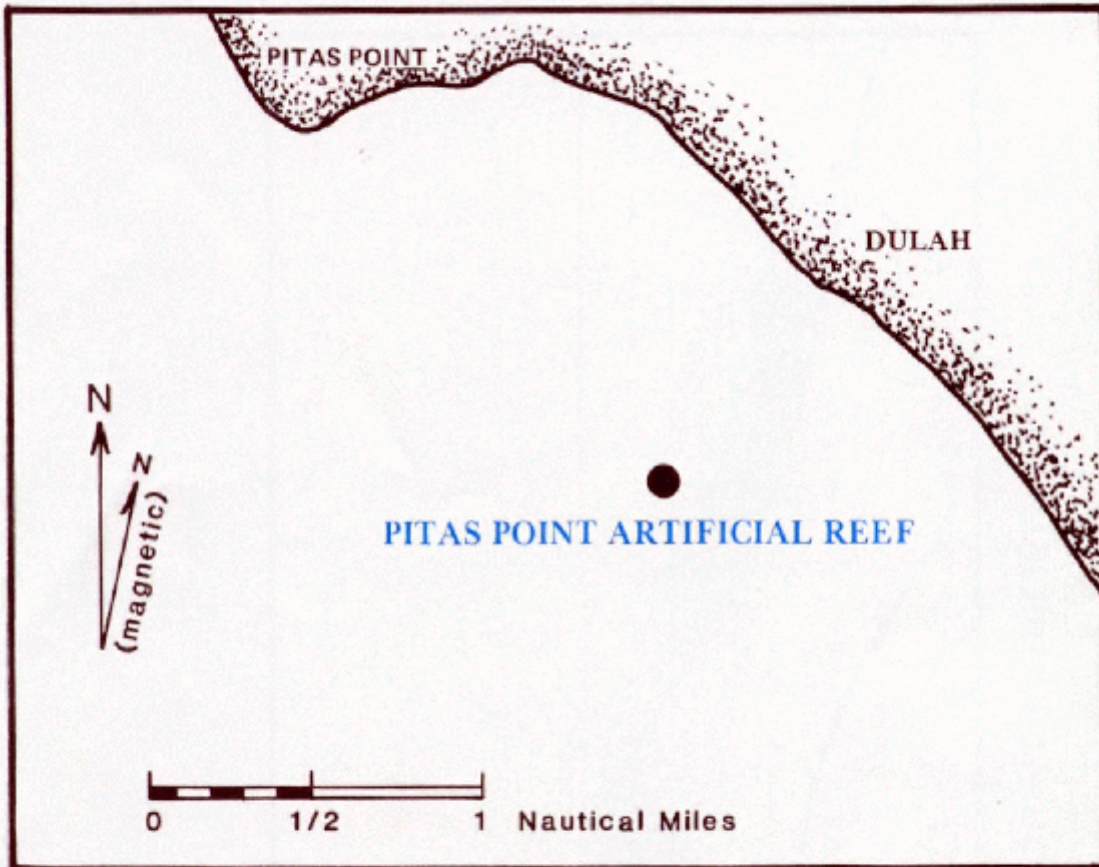


PITAS POINT ARTIFICIAL REEF

Materials Used	7,200 tons quarry rock	
Comments	Reef supports a healthy stand of giant kelp which forms a surface canopy. Feather-boa kelp is also present, forming a lower-story canopy. Kelp bass, barred sandbass, olive and brown rockfishes and several species of surfperches are common.

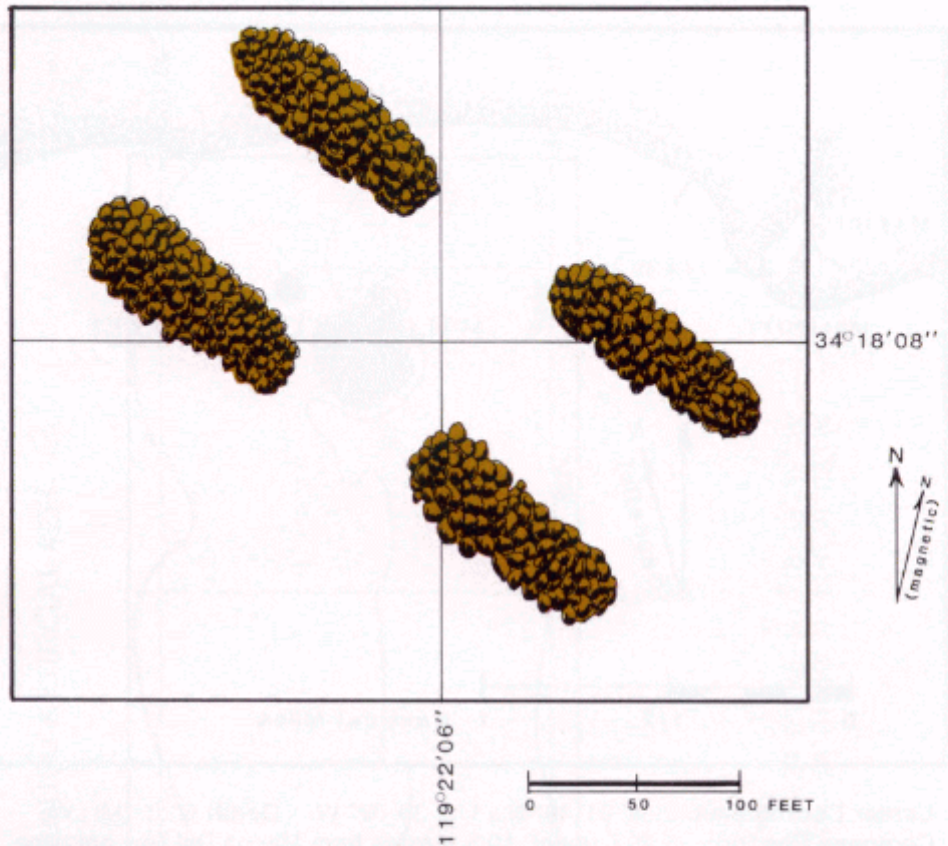
