

# MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT

## March 2008



### Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

### Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

### San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 108 landings in March. The majority of the landings took place during the first two weeks of the month. Fishing took place off Pt. Vicente, Pt. Fermin, Huntington Flats, Oceanside, Del Mar, La Jolla, San Diego, and Santa Catalina Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 45 g (+/-15 g SD\*) and the average mantle length was 133 mm (+/-11 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$600/short ton (\$661/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, Pacific mackerel, jack mackerel, and kelp.
