April 2008



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 9 landings in April. Fishing took place off Huntington Flats, Newport Beach, and Santa Catalina Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 36 g (+/- 9 g SD*) and the average mantle length was 121 mm (+/-11 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$600/short ton (\$661/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine. High winds and large swells hampered fishing efforts this month. The quality of sampled squid was excellent. The mantles were firm and thick, and the females were full of eggs.
