MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT April 2009



Monterey

There were 12 landings in April. Fishing took place off Carmel and Big Sur. The average weight of sampled squid was 31 g (+/-9 g SD*) and the average mantle length was 115 mm (+/-15 mm SD). There were some small squid sampled in the landings (60-90 mm) with a few juveniles of indeterminate sex. The average ex-vessel price was \$700/short ton (\$772/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included jellyfish, northern anchovies, Pacific mackerel, and kelp.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were no landings of squid reported this month.
