# MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT April 2010



## Monterey/Moss Landing

There were 139 landings in April. Fishing took place off Marina, Monterey, and San Simeon. The average weight of sampled squid was 37 g (+/- 10 g SD) and the average mantle length was 120 mm (+/- 12 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$500/short ton (\$550/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included pompano, Pacific sardine, ragfish, hornyhead turbot, Pacific sanddab, sand sole, Pacific electric ray, Dungeness crab, graceful crab, hydroid cluster, sea whip, jellyfish, sea star, Turkish towel, kelp and squid eggs.

### Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There was 1 landing in April. Fishing took place off Santa Rosa Island. There were no samples taken, so there was no observed incidental catch.

#### San Pedro/Terminal Island

There was 1 landing in April. Fishing took place off Pt. Dume. There were no samples taken, so there was no observed incidental catch.
