MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT May 2010



Monterey/Moss Landing

There were 61 landings in May. Fishing took place off Marina and Monterey. Landings decreased throughout the month due to heavy winds and a drop in ocean temperatures. During the beginning of the month, good quantities of small squid (50 mm) were landed. The average weight of sampled squid was 32 g (+/- 14 g SD) and the average mantle length was 116 mm (+/- 21 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$500/short ton (\$550/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, northern anchovy, plainfin midshipman, brown rockfish, unidentified flatfish, Pacific sanddab, Dungeness crab, black spotted bay shrimp, jellyfish, marine worm, sea star, kelp, and squid eggs.
