MONTHLY SQUID REPORT June 2007



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were 19 landings in June. Fishing primarily took place off the south side of Santa Rosa Island and the north side of Santa Cruz Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 40 +/- 12 g (1SD) and the average mantle length was 124 +/- 13 mm (1SD). The ex-vessel price averaged \$500 per short ton (\$551 per metric ton). Observed incidental bycatch included Northern anchovy, Pacific sardine, Pacific mackerel, kelp, unidentified crab and a soda can.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were three landings in June. Vessels fished off Huntington Beach and Santa Catalina Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 31 g (+/- 10.8 SD) and the average mantle length was 115 mm (+/- 14.6 SD). The ex-vessel price averaged \$500/short ton (\$551/metric ton). Observed incidental bycatch included Pacific sardine.
