MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT June 2008



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were 12 landings in June. Fishing took place off of Santa Rosa Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 42 g (+/-15 g SD*) and the average mantle length was 130 mm (+/-16 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$658 per short ton (\$725 per metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 37 landings in June. Fishing took place off Santa Catalina Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 40 g (+/-12 g SD) and the average mantle length was 122 mm (+/-13 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$700/short ton (\$772/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, Pacific mackerel, jack mackerel, northern anchovy, staghorn sculpin, unidentified juvenile rockfish, spotted turbot, speckled sanddab, unidentified sanddab, unidentified flatfish, unidentified crab, squid egg cases, eel grass, kelp, feather boa kelp, and red algae.
