MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT June 2009



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There was 1 landing in June. Fishing took place off Santa Rosa Island. No samples were taken, so there was no incidental catch observed.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 66 landings in June. Fishing took place off Santa Catalina Island and San Clemente Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 35 g (+/-9 SD) and the average mantle length was 118 mm (+/-10 SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$700/short ton (\$771/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included flying fish, slender snipefish, Pacific sardine, Pacific mackerel, jack mackerel, northern anchovy, unidentified midshipmen, CA scorpionfish, unidentified turbots, crabs, squid eggs, sea stars, and kelp.
