

MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT

July 2007



Monterey

There were 2 landings in July. Fishing took place off Monterey. The average weight of sampled squid was 29 g (+/- 6 g SD) and the average mantle length was 112 mm (+/- 7mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$600/short ton (\$660/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, jack mackerel, Pacific sanddab, and Turkish towel.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were 25 landings in July. Fishing took place off the north and south sides of Santa Rosa Island and the north side of San Miguel Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 48 g (+/- 11 g SD) and the average mantle length was 133 mm (+/- 10 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$556/short ton (\$613/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, Pacific and jack mackerel, northern anchovy, and kelp.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 10 landings in July. Fishing took place off Santa Catalina Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 41 g (+/- 11 g SD) and the average mantle length was 123 mm (+/- 13 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$590/short ton (\$650/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine and Pacific mackerel.
