MONTHLY SQUID REPORT AUGUST

Monterey

Vessels landing in this port complex fished near the Monterey Bay Aquarium. The month started off with no landings because fishermen reported spent squid. By the middle of August, fishing picked up but the ex-vessel price was only \$100/ton because the squid were small and skinny. Fishing was tougher by late August because squid were hard to find.

Southern California

There were no landings in Ventura/Port Hueneme. Many vessels are currently tied up in Ventura Harbor waiting for the next season to start. Most processors claim squid fishing will start by late September or early October.

There were no landings in San Pedro/Terminal Island. Vessels at this port complex targeted wetfish species.
