MONTHLY SQUID REPORT September 2004



Monterey

Lack of squid and elevated water temperatures slowed down fishing for most of the month. Some squid, however, were found around Año Nuevo, Monterey State Beach, and Rocky Point. The ex-vessel price was \$420-500/ton. Pacific sardine, anchovy, California grunion, jacksmelt, and jellyfish were observed as bycatch.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were no landings of squid reported this month, but squid were seen as bycatch in several wetfish landings.
