MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT September 2007



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were 2 landings in September. Fishing took place off east Santa Rosa Island and south Santa Cruz Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 39 g (+/- 15 g SD) and the average mantle length was 123 mm (+/- 15 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$600/short ton (\$661/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included a sheep crab and kelp.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 4 landings in September. Fishing took place off Santa Catalina Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 34 g (+/- 9 g SD) and the average mantle length was 116 mm (+/- 12 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$600/short ton (\$661/metric ton). There was no observed incidental catch.
