There were seven landings this month. All occurred during the last week of October. Fishing took place off Pt. Vicente and Redondo Beach. Squid size varied, ranging from 25 to 68 grams. No bycatch was observed.

A few local purse seine vessels made some exploratory squid trips up to the Channel Islands late October. They reportedly found a few tons, but rough weather prevented them from making any more trips for the remainder of the month.
