MONTHLY SQUID REPORT October 2006



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were thirteen landings in October. Fishing activity occurred off the south side of Santa Cruz Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 36 g (+/- 10 s.d.), and the average mantle length was 119 mm (+/- 11 s.d.). The ex-vessel price ranged from \$440-500/ton (\$485-551/mt). Observed incidental catch included Pacific mackerel, Pacific sardine, bonito, bat rays, butterfish, and ocean sunfish.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were no landings of squid reported this month.
