## Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

## Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were five landings in October. Fishing took place off Santa Cruz Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 43 g (+/-11 g SD) and the average mantle length was 127 mm (+/-11 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$700/short ton (\$772/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, unidentified sanddab, and kelp.

## San Pedro/Terminal Island

There was 1 landing in October. The landing did not occur until the end of the month. Fishing took place off Santa Cruz Island.
