MONTHLY SQUID REPORT November 2005



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

Squid landings at Ventura Harbor and Port Hueneme resumed this month, but many vessels stayed further south to fish around Santa Catalina Island. Fishing took place off the north side of Santa Cruz Island, Point Mugu, and Hueneme Canyon. Reports indicated that there were approximately eight to ten squid per pound. The exvessel price ranged from \$450-550/ton. Pacific mackerel, Pacific sardine, northern anchovy, and kelp were all observed as bycatch.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

Squid landings increased this month by over 2,000 tons, with 37 percent of the monthly total landed during the last three days of November. Load sizes varied considerably, ranging from one to 60 tons with an average of 16 tons. Squid were well developed and of good quality. The ex-vessel price ranged from \$500-600/ton. Pacific mackerel, Pacific sardine, jack mackerel, northern anchovy, and kelp were observed as bycatch.

To help alleviate some of the fishing pressure at Santa Catalina Island, a few vessels began looking for squid in alternative locations. A few caught squid around Santa Monica Bay, Manhattan Beach, Pt. Vicente, Pt. Fermin, Huntington Flats, and Santa Cruz Island; however, most vessels still concentrated their fishing efforts around Santa Catalina Island.
