MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT November 2008



Monterey

There were no landings of squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were 39 landings in November. Strong winds and rough seas affected fishing efforts. There was a lot of fishing pressure but squid was reportedly hard to find. Fishing took place off Santa Rosa Island and Santa Cruz Island. The average weight of sampled squid was 40 g (+/-10 g SD*) and the average mantle length was 127 mm (+/-11 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$684/short ton (\$754/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific sardine, Pacific mackerel, and kelp.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 6 landings in November. The majority of the fleet fished the northern Channel Islands. Fishing took place off Santa Cruz Island. The average ex-vessel price was \$700/short ton (\$772/metric ton). None of the landings were observed.
