TRIBUTARY TO: Klamath River

DATE OF SURVEY: December 8, 1994

PURPOSE OF SURVEY: Spawner Survey

LOCATION OF SURVEY: From upstream barriers to downstream enhancement area  
for 2.5 miles.

METHOD OF SURVEY: On foot, visual.

OBSERVATIONS: (no redds, no carcasses, no live fish)  
Air Temperature: 46 F  
Water Temperature: 44 F  
Visibility: good  
Weather: clear  
Flow: moderate

COMMENTS: One-third mile of East Fork Hunter Creek was surveyed. Redds, carcasses, and live fish were not found.

Between high flows, the enhancement reaches were spot checked on January 12, 1995, February 8, 1995, and February 20, 1995. Redds, carcasses, and live fish were not found.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Young of the year survey should be conducted to determine if any anadromous fish have successfully spawned on Hunter Creek.
