Date of Survey: March 17, 1994

Purpose of Survey: Steelhead spawner survey

Location: Mouth located T13N, R1E, Sec. 4. Surveyed section began about 4 miles upstream of mouth.

Method of Survey: Visual by walking

Surveyors: D. McLeod, L. Preston

Observations: A 3.6 mile section of West Fork Hunter Creek was surveyed from a wet ford crossing located in T14N, R1E, SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 2, downstream to East Fork Hunter Creek in Section 23. Flow was low and visibility excellent. Only 5 steelhead redds were observed, along with one older salmon redd. This is an extremely low number of redds for the distance surveyed.
