Date of Survey: August 22-25, 1983

Purpose of Survey: Adult spring-run steelhead inventory

Location: From Highway 299 bridge crossing, downstream to RNP Tall Trees Grove (Emerald Cr.) approximately 29 miles.

Method of Survey: Visual observation by walking and swimming.

Equipment Used: Face mask and snorkle

Surveyors: Steve Heimlich, Judy Ganz Haggard (DFG); Dave Anderson, Randy Brown (RNP)

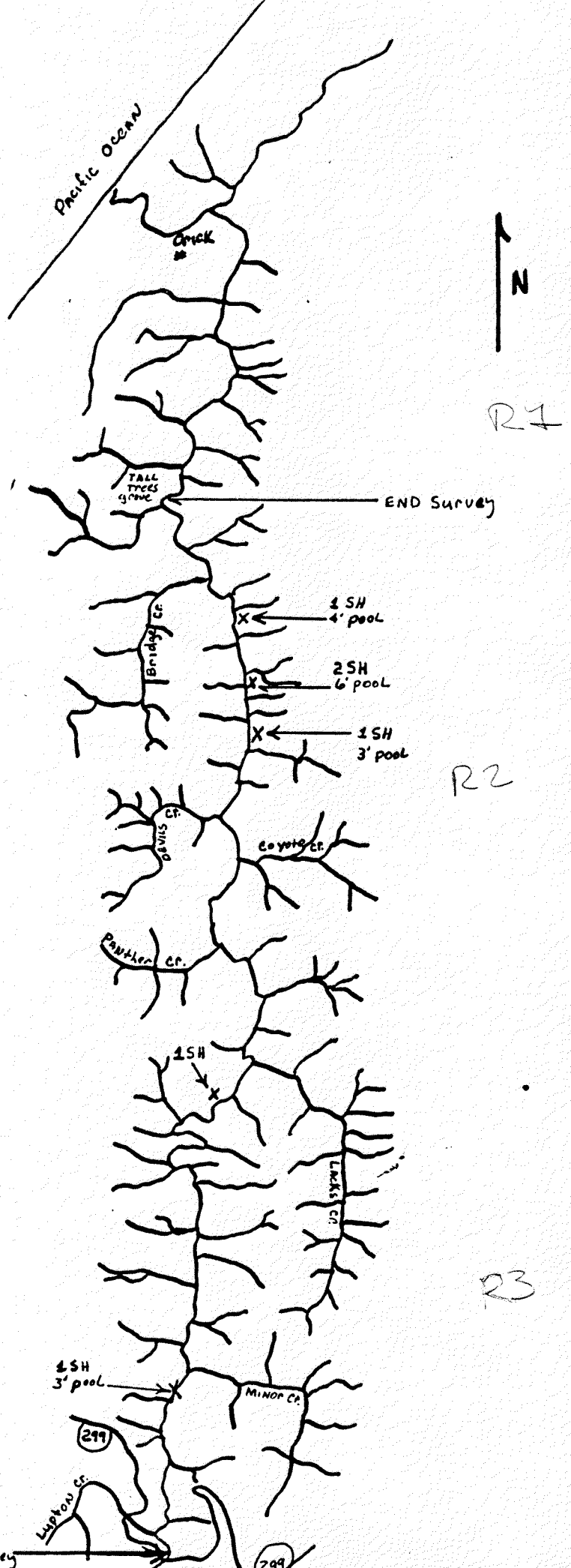
Observations: Six adult steelhead were seen with estimated size ranging from 23 to 30". All six fish were in good condition and light in color. Other fish seen were trout, stickleback and suckers. Trout were present in low numbers. Generally, the channel was aggraded and pools for steelhead holding were few.

Recommendations: Future surveys should skip the section from Highway 299 to Stover Cr. The few pools through this section have easy road access and are used for swimming.

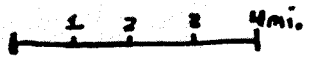
