Observations:

Cow creek was surveyed from the confluence with Bull Creek upstream to 1450' above the mouth on January 22, 1988. Eight live adult chinook and eleven chinook carcasses were observed during the survey. The weather was clear but visibility of the water was 2-4' deep. Water temperature was not taken. Most of the spawning salmon and carcasses were found from the mouth to the culvert under Bull Creek road.
