1985 Spring Run Steelhead and Salmon Inventory in Wooley Creek

Wooley Creek was surveyed in the same way as in previous years, from the upstream limits of migration in the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, T.42N., R.12W, MDBM to Deerlick Creek. This year's count of 290 steelhead was the highest since 1977 and the second highest since inventories have been made.

The following tables breakdown the count by area and recaps previous surveys.
