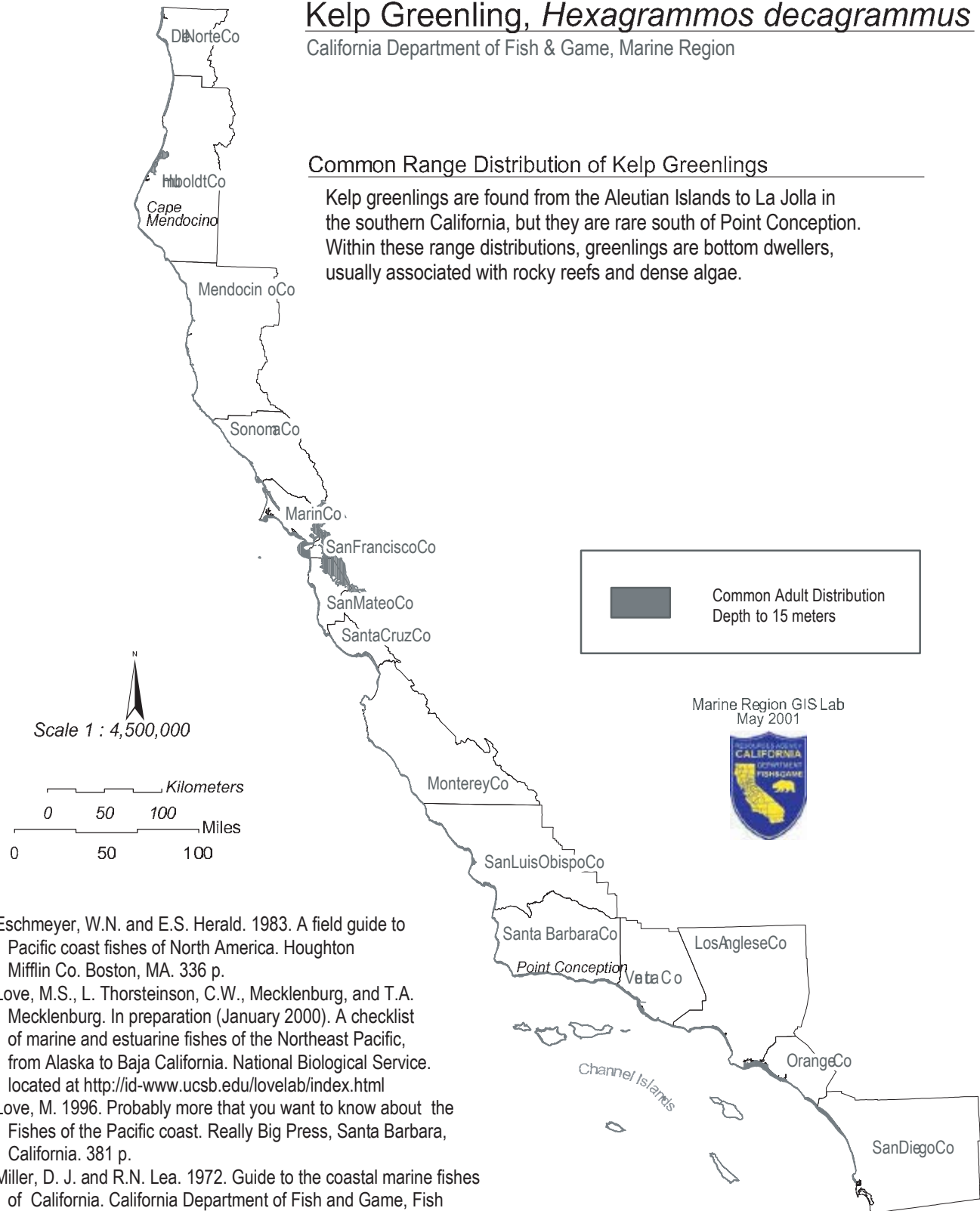


Kelp Greenling, *Hexagrammos decagrammus*

Common Range Distribution of Kelp Greenlings

Kelp greenlings are found from the Aleutian Islands to La Jolla in the southern California, but they are rare south of Point Conception. Within these range distributions, greenlings are bottom dwellers, usually associated with rocky reefs and dense algae.
