

FAR OFFSHORE FISHERY DECLARATION

(DEPARTURE PORTION)

Fish and Game Code §8113

(a) Prior to departure from any port in the United States for the purpose of taking fish in the far offshore fishery, the operator of any vessel landing fish in California that will be taken in the far offshore fishery shall file a declaration with the department on forms prescribed by the department.

(b) The declaration shall be valid when signed by the vessel operator and completed with information prescribed by the department.

The declaration shall be submitted to the following CA Department of Fish and Wildlife office within 12 hours of arrival:

I also understand that no species of marlin and no shark fins (with the exception of unaltered thresher shark tails and fins in possession with the corresponding carcasses) may be possessed aboard a commercial fishing vessel registered pursuant to Section 7881 of the Fish and Game Code.
