



# DOMESTICATED GAME BREEDER'S LICENSE RENEWAL NOTICE

## 2017 Domesticated Game Breeders License Information

Your current Domesticated Game Breeder's License will expire December 31, 2016.

## No Cash Accepted at Department Offices

Starting January 1, 2017, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife will no longer accept cash at CDFW's License and Revenue Branch and regional license counters. Checks, money orders, or any debit or credit card with the Visa or Mastercard logo are accepted.

## Federal Permits May Also Be Required

A United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) Migratory Bird Waterfowl Sales and Disposal Permit is required to sell, donate or otherwise dispose of to another person, properly marked, captive-reared migratory waterfowl and their eggs, except for mallards.

A USFWS Special Purpose Game Bird Permit is required to acquire, purchase, possess, transfer, sell, donate or otherwise dispose of to another person, migratory game birds (excluding waterfowl) that are captive-reared and properly marked, including their eggs. ## Deadline to Submit Report

FGC Section 3208 requires licensees to submit a Domesticated Game Breeder's Report Form to the Department **on or before January 31 of each year.**

If you renew your license early, or do not have any change in stock, or if you are not renewing your license, because you no longer possess domesticated game birds or mammals, you are still required to complete and submit a Domesticated Game Breeder's Report Form to the Department on or before January 31, 2017

## Domesticated Game Bird Seals

Pursuant to FGC Section 3206 no domesticated game bird shall be transported or sold dead unless the carcass of each large mammal, the carcass of each bird, except as provided in FGC Section 2401 for domesticated game birds raised outside this State is tagged with a Domesticated Game Breeder's Seal.

## Game Defined

This permit is only for species of birds and mammals which are game in California. Game is defined in Fish and Game Code (FGC) Sections 3500 and 3950. The FGC is available at [www.leginfo.ca.gov](http://www.leginfo.ca.gov).

**Note:** Items purchased from Online License Sales and Services will include five percent (5%) nonrefundable license agent handling fee.

## Check List for Renewing Your Domesticated Game Breeder's License

- ✓ Review the preprinted information carefully, line through incorrect information, and legibly print corrections.
- ✓ Sign, and date your renewal worksheet.
- ✓ Complete, sign, and date the 2016 Domesticated Game Breeder's Report Form.
- ✓ Enclose your check or money order.
- ✓ If paying by credit card, sign the enclosed form and include the expiration date of the credit card, CVC number on the back of the card and your daytime telephone number.
- ✓ Allow 15 business days for your worksheet to be processed.

## To Renew Your License Online

1. Sign into your profile at [www.ca.wildlifelicense.com/InternetSales](http://www.ca.wildlifelicense.com/InternetSales)  
You will need your last name, date of birth and GO ID# found under the barcode, on the upper right hand of your 2017 Domesticated Game Breeder's License Renewal, or on your current license.
2. Click "View My Special Permits" in the Menu box at the top of the page.
3. Click the "View" button next to the Game Breeder special permit type.
4. Scan your Domesticated Game Breeder's Report for 2016 and upload to the 2017 application year by clicking the "Upload File" button.
5. Click the "New Application" button under the Game Breeder Application Listing.
6. Update all information on the 2017 Game Breeder Application page.
7. Check the signature box at the bottom of the page and click the "Submit and Finish" button.
8. Under the Menu box, click "2017 – Permits"
9. Click the "Add to Cart" button next to the license Class type you would like to purchase.

10. Confirm your selections under the Shopping Cart box and click the "Checkout" button.
11. Confirm your shipping information and enter your payment information.
12. To receive confirmation of your purchases, enter your email address and check the email confirmation box.
13. **Important:** Check the box to certify that you are 18 years of age and authorized to make the purchase. The transaction will not be processed if it is not checked, which means you have not renewed your Domesticated Game Breeder's License.
14. Click the "Complete Transaction" button. The transaction complete page will appear, confirming you have completed the sales and have applied for your Domesticated Game Breeder's License. Click on the "Download Receipt/Licenses" to print your receipt for you records.
