



2018 DOMESTICATED GAME BREEDER'S LICENSE RENEWAL NOTICE

2018 Domesticated Game Breeder's License Information

Your 2017 Domesticated Game Breeder's License will expire December 31, 2017.

No Cash Accepted at Department Offices

As of January 1, 2017, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) will no longer accept cash at the License and Revenue Branch and regional license sales offices. Checks, money orders, or any debit or credit card with the Visa or Mastercard logo are accepted.

Federal Permits May Also Be Required

A United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) Migratory Bird Waterfowl Sales and Disposal Permit is required to sell, donate or otherwise dispose of to another person, properly marked, captive-reared migratory waterfowl and their eggs, except for mallards.

A USFWS Special Purpose Game Bird Permit is required to acquire, purchase, possess, transfer, sell, donate or otherwise dispose of to another person, migratory game birds (excluding waterfowl) that are captive-reared and properly marked, including their eggs. Domesticated Game Breeder's List

If you have stock available for sale to the public, please check the box on the renewal worksheet if you want the name of your business posted on the Department's website.

Deadline to Submit Report

Fish and Game Code (FGC) Section 3208 requires licensees to submit a Domesticated Game Breeder's Report Form to the Department **on or before January 31 of each year.**

If you renew your license early, or do not have any change in stock, or if you are not renewing your license, because you no longer possess domesticated game birds or mammals, you are still required to complete and submit a Domesticated Game Breeder's Report Form to the Department on or before January 31, 2018.

Domesticated Game Bird Seals

Pursuant to FGC Section 3206 no domesticated game bird shall be transported or sold dead unless the carcass of each large mammal, the carcass of each bird, except as provided in FGC Section 2401 for domesticated game birds raised outside this State is tagged with a Domesticated Game Breeder's Seal.

Game Defined

This permit is only for species of birds and mammals which are game in California. Game is defined in FGC Sections 3500 and 3950. The FGC is available at <https://leginfo.ca.gov/faces/codes.xhtml>

Renew Your Domesticated Game Breeder's License Online

You can renew your Game Breeder's License Renewal online by logging in to your Online License Sales and Service account (see "Steps to Renew Your License Online" for instructions). **Note:** Items purchased from the Online License Sales and Service system include a five percent (5%) nonrefundable license agent handling fee.

Check list for Renewing Your Domesticated Game Breeder's License

Please read the instructions before completing the worksheet. Incomplete worksheets will be returned and may delay the issuance of your permit. Please remember to do the following:

- ✓ Review the preprinted information carefully, line through incorrect information, and legibly print corrections.
- ✓ Sign, and date your renewal worksheet.
- ✓ Complete, sign, and date the 2017 Domesticated Game Breeder's Report Form.
- ✓ Enclose your check or money order.
- ✓ If paying by credit card, sign the enclosed form and include the expiration date of the credit card, CVC number on the back of the card and your daytime telephone number.
- ✓ Allow 15 business days for your worksheet to be processed.
