



2018 FALLOW DEER FARMING PERMIT RENEWAL NOTICE

2018 Fallow Deer Farming Permit Information

Your current permit will expire December 31, 2017. Please **allow 30 business days** for processing the renewal of your permit and an **additional 30 business days** when requesting a California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) inspection.

No Cash Accepted At Department Offices

As of January 1, 2017, the Department no longer accepts cash at its License and Revenue Branch and regional license sales offices. Checks, money orders, or any debit or credit card with the Visa or Mastercard logo are accepted.

Renew Your Permit Online

You can renew your Fallow Deer Farming Permit online by logging in to your Online License Sales and Service account (see the instructions on the second page).

Note: Items purchased from Online License Sales and Services include a five percent (5%) nonrefundable license agent handling fee.

Fallow Deer Stock for Sale

If you have stock available for sale to the public, please check the box on the renewal worksheet if you want the name of your business posted on the Department's website.

Checklist for Renewing Your Fallow Deer Farming Permit

Please read the instructions before completing the worksheet. **Incomplete** worksheets will be returned and may **delay** the issuance of your permit. Please remember to do the following:

- ✓ Review the preprinted information carefully, line through incorrect information, and legibly print corrections.
- ✓ Complete, sign, and date the Fallow Deer Farming Permit Worksheet.
- ✓ Enclose your check or money order.
- ✓ When paying with a credit card, sign the enclosed form and include the expiration date of the credit card, CVC number, and your daytime telephone number.

Permit Termination Notice


Section 676(b)(6), Title 14, of the California Code of Regulations requires any fully or partially certified fallow deer farming permittee to **notify the Department within 45 days of its intended termination of fallow deer farming operations.**



Fallow Deer Importation

If you plan to import fallow deer from outside California, you must receive specific written approval from the Department. Please submit a completed Cervidae Importation Application (DFW 1676a) to the address listed on the application prior to purchasing and importing fallow deer.

Renew Your Fallow Deer Farming Permit Online

Read this first: To log in, you will need your last name, date of birth, and GO ID (found under the barcode on the front of your Fallow Deer Farming Permit Renewal Worksheet or your current permit).

1. Visit www.ca.wildlifelicense.com/InternetSales/.
2. Click on the "Customer Login/Register" tab.
(For mobile devices, click the  icon towards the top left and select "Customer Login/Register.")
3. Enter the individual's Date of Birth and Last Name, and click "Next."
4. Under "Select Official Document ID Type," select an appropriate ID registered with the account from the drop down menu (i.e. GO ID, State ID, Passport, Green Card, Military ID, or Foreign Government ID), enter the requested information, and click "Next." If prompted, update your information and click "Save" to complete the update. Otherwise, click "Cancel Updates" to continue.

Individual Profile Update: If you would like to update the individual customer profile, click the "Edit Customer Profile" button, update the necessary information, and click "Save." (For mobile devices, click on the  icon towards the top left, click on "Edit Customer Profile," update the necessary information, and click "Save.")
5. Click "View My Special Permits."
(For mobile devices, click the  icon towards the top left and select "View My Special Permits.")
6. Under "Permits on File," locate your Fallow Deer Farming permit and click "View."
7. Click on "New Application" to create a Fallow Deer Farming Permit Renewal Application. **Note:** If there is no "New Application" button, click "Edit" next to the appropriate Application Year.
8. Update all information on the renewal application page.

Uploading a document: Click "Add" under "File Uploads" and then click "Browse." Select the file on your computer/device that you wish to upload and click "Upload."

9. Scroll down and check the box to certify under penalty of perjury that the application is true and correct.
10. Click "Submit And Finish."
11. Confirm the selections in your Shopping Cart and click "Checkout."
12. Confirm your shipping information and enter your payment information. **Note:** Only Visa and MasterCard are accepted.
13. To receive a purchase confirmation via email, check the box next to "Please Email Confirmation" and enter an email address. Check the box certifying you are at least 18 years of age and authorized to make the selected purchase. **The transaction will not proceed if the box is not checked.**
14. Click "Complete Transaction."
15. The "Transaction Complete" page will appear, confirming you have completed the purchase and have submitted your Fallow Deer Farming Permit Renewal Application. Click on "Download Receipt/Licenses" to print your receipt for your records. **Please allow 30 days for processing.**
