

MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT

February 2011



Monterey/Moss Landing

There were no landings of market squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were no landings of market squid reported this month.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 246 landings of market squid in February. Fishing took place off Point Vicente, Point Fermin, Long Beach, Huntington Flats, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, and Santa Catalina Island. Brailed landings of two tons or less continued this month. The average weight of sampled squid was 26 g (+/- 5 g SD*) and the average mantle length was 112 mm (+/- 7 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$558/short ton (\$615/metric ton). There was no incidental catch observed.
