

MONTHLY MARKET SQUID REPORT

January 2011



Monterey/Moss Landing

There were no landings of market squid reported this month.

Ventura/Port Hueneme/Santa Barbara

There were no landings of market squid reported this month.

San Pedro/Terminal Island

There were 169 landings of market squid in January. Fishing took place off Santa Monica, Manhattan Beach, Redondo Beach, Point Vicente, Point Fermin, Long Beach, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, Laguna Beach, Mission Beach, and Santa Catalina Island. Landings averaging two tons continue to trickle in daily. The quality seems to be less than stellar with small squid bodies and thin mantles. The average weight of sampled squid was 29 g (+/- 6 g SD*) and the average mantle length was 114 mm (+/- 8 mm SD). The average ex-vessel price was \$562/short ton (\$619/metric ton). Observed incidental catch included Pacific mackerel and Pacific sardine.
