Please allow 15 business days for processing. Incomplete applications will be returned and could delay the issuance of your license. Contact the License and Revenue Branch at (916) 928-5845 or spu@wildlife.ca.gov if you need additional information regarding Biological Supply House Permits.

- 1. It is mandatory to complete all items.
- 2. Sign and date the application.
- 3. A copy of applicable city or county business permits must accompany the completed application.
- 4. Mail this application, a copy of your identification and copies of applicable city or county business permits with a cashier's check, money order, personal check*, or credit card authorization** form with the appropriate fee to the Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, 1740 N. Market Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95834 or apply in person. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**

Note: In addition to the Biological Supply House Permit, a Field Collecting Permit is required. Field Collecting Permits are issued by the regional office where the collecting will take place. Please contact the appropriate regional office listed below.

Permits To Take Bullfrogs For Sale To Scientific or Educational Institutions.

Pursuant to Section 658, Title 14, of the CCR, permits to take bullfrogs for sale to scientific or educational institutions require Fish and Game Commission approval. You may contact the Commission and ask to be placed on the agenda of one of their regularly scheduled meeting. You must provide the Department and the Commission the necessary documentation required in Section 658, Title 14, of the CCR. In addition to the permit, each person collecting bullfrogs for a qualified scientific or educational institution must possess a Commercial Fishing License and a Scientific Collecting Permit. Each boat used for the purpose of collecting bullfrogs must also be registered as a commercial fishing vessel.

INDIVIDUAL AND BUSINESS IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Section 700.4(c), Title 14, of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) states any applicant applying for any license, tag, permit, reservation or other entitlement issued via the Automated License Data System (ALDS) shall provide valid identification. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Any license document or Get Outdoors identification number (GO ID) previously issued via ALDS
- A valid driver's license or identification card issued to him or her by the Department of Motor Vehicles or by the entity issuing driver's licenses from the licensee's state of domicile
- US Military Identification Cards (Active or reserve duty, dependent, retired member, discharged from service, medical/religious personnel)
- US Birth Certificate
- US Certificate or Report of Birth Abroad
- Tribal Identification Card, as defined by each sovereign tribal nation
- US Passport
- A foreign government-issued photo identification
- Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship
- Birth Certificate or passport issued from a US Territory

Any applicant less than 18 years of age applying for any license, tag, permit, reservation or other entitlement issued via the ALDS shall provide valid identification. Acceptable forms of identification include any form of identification described above; or a parent or legal guardian's identification as described above.

All business applicants must provide documentation identifying the business' structure type. Acceptable forms of business identification include:

- · Articles of Incorporation
- · Statement of Partnership
- Registration as a Limited Liability Partnership; or
- Certificate of Limited Partnership
- Statement of Partnerhip Authority
- Statement of Sole Proprietorship

If a business' identification names individual(s), each individual must provide a valid individual identification as described above and provide their date of birth, sex, hair and eye color, height and weight.

NOTICE

Disclosure Statement - Under Fish and Game Code and Title 14, of the CCR, the Department of Fish and Wildlife is authorized to collect information from applicants to maintain a record of licensure. All information requested on this application is mandatory unless otherwise indicated. An applicant's name and city of residence may be provided to the public if requested. Other personal information submitted on this application may be released for law enforcement purposes, pursuant to court order, or for official natural resources management purposes.

A licensee may obtain a copy of his/her license records maintained by the Department by submitting a written request to the Custodian of Records, Department of Fish and Wildlife, License and Revenue Branch, 1740 N. Market Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95834 or Irb@wildlife.ca.gov. All requests must include the requester's name, address, and telephone number.

PAYMENT POLICY

- * Personal or business checks will be accepted by the Department if a name and address are imprinted on the check. Checks returned to the Department due to insufficient funds will render your permit invalid. The Department may also deny the issuance or renewal of any permit if a person has failed to reimburse the Department for the amount due. Any activity performed without a valid permit is a violation of the Fish and Game Code and therefore subject to enforcement action.
- **Credit Cards Licenses, permits, tags, stamps, or registrations may be purchased with a Visa or MasterCard.
