What is the California Fishing Passport Program?



A new fishing incentive and angler recognition program to highlight and promote fishing throughout the state. California Fishing Passports serve as the basis of the program and list 150 different species of popular

fresh and saltwater finfish and shellfish that occur in California. Anglers are encouraged to get out, go fishing, and try to catch one of every species listed. For each new species caught, anglers receive a stamp in their passport book documenting each achievement and then become eligible for additional recognition and awards.

How Does the Program Work?



Each time a new species is caught, the angler takes a photo of the fish or asks a witness to sign the passport entry to verify the catch. Next, the angler takes book and any verifying photos to an authorized stamping agent to certify

the catch and stamp their book. The more stamps you earn, the more awards and prizes you may earn. For a list of all stamping locations, go to:




