

CBDA Mercury Annual Review Workshop Call for Posters

The California Bay-Delta Authority and UC Davis Extension invite participants in the CBDA Mercury Annual Review Workshop to submit posters for mercury-related research projects, restoration projects addressing mercury issues, and information about other coordination, outreach and education activities related to mercury. The Poster Session will run from 10:00-12:00 on Thursday, December 1, the last day of the workshop, following a one-hour overview session.

Poster Session Guidelines

Submission Information

Priority – Due to space limitations, we can display a maximum of 40 48” by 48” posters. If larger posters are displayed, fewer posters will be able to be displayed. Posters will be selected from the abstracts submitted to allow a well-rounded presentation of mercury related activities and research relevant to the Bay-Delta system.

Abstracts – Abstracts will be required before posters are approved for display. Send abstracts via email to Allen Barnes (ambarnes@ucdavis.edu) before Friday, November 18. Please inquire about space availability if you cannot make that deadline.

Poster Setup – Posters may be given to Workshop support staff anytime during the first two days of the workshop, or sent separately in advance. In any event, posters must be received no later than 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, December 1.

Size – We recommend that posters be no larger than 48" x 48". Please state in your abstract submission if your poster is larger than this size.

What type of posters would we like to have?

We are encouraging this poster session to facilitate interchange between the various research activities (funded by CBDA or others), restoration managers with research or monitoring related to mercury in restoration, remediation projects, coordination efforts, and outreach and education activities related to mercury contamination. We would also like to encourage non-technical posters that would be of interest to restoration managers and the general public.
