2018 Live Freshwater Bait Fish License Information

Your 2017 Live Freshwater Bait Fish License will expire December 31, 2017.

Live Freshwater Bait Fish Licenses are only issued by mail from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife's (Department) License and Revenue Branch, located in Sacramento.

No Cash Accepted at Department Offices

As of January 1, 2017, the Department no longer accepts cash at the License and Revenue Branch and regional license sales offices. Checks, money orders, or any debit or credit card with the Visa or Mastercard logo are accepted.

Business Documentation

All applicants applying as a business must provide documentation showing the business entity. Acceptable forms include the following:

- Articles of Incorporation
- Articles of Organization
- Certificate of Limited Partnership
- Statement of Partnership Authority

Please read the instructions before completing the application. Incomplete applications will be returned and may delay the issuance of your permit. Please remember to do the following:

- ✓ Review the preprinted information carefully, line through incorrect information, and legibly print corrections.
- ✓ Enclose your check or money order.
- ✓ If paying by credit card, sign the enclosed credit card authorization form and include the expiration date of the credit card, CVC number on the back of the card, and your daytime telephone number.
- ✓ Allow four to six weeks for your application to be processed.
