2017 Live Freshwater Bait Fish License Information

Your current Live Freshwater Bait Fish License will expire December 31, 2016.

Live Freshwater Bait Fish License's are issued only at the Department of Fish and Wildlife's License and Revenue Branch, in Sacramento by mail.

No Cash Accepted at Department Offices

Starting January 1, 2017, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife will no longer accept cash at the License and Revenue Branch and regional license counters. Checks, money orders, or any debit or credit card with the Visa or Mastercard logo are accepted.

Business Documentation

All applicants applying as a business must provide documentation stating the business entity. Acceptable forms include:

- Articles of Incorporation
- Articles of Organization
- Certificate of Limited Partnership
- Statement of Partnership Authority

Check List for Renewing Your Live Freshwater Bait Fish License

- ✓ Review the preprinted information carefully, line through incorrect information, and legibly print corrections.
- ✓ Sign and date your renewal application.
- ✓ Enclose your check or money order.
- ✓ When paying by credit card, sign the enclosed credit card authorization form and include the expiration date of the credit card, CVC number on the back of the card and your daytime telephone number.
- ✓ Allow four to six weeks for your application to be processed.
