



CALIFORNIA HALIBUT BOTTOM TRAWL VESSEL PERMIT TRANSFER APPLICATION

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Pursuant to Fish and Game Code (FGC), Section 8494(d)(3), the permit holder of a California Halibut Bottom Trawl Vessel Permit (CHBTVP), or his or her conservator or estate representative, may transfer the permit simultaneously with the vessel to a new permit holder if the following conditions are met to the satisfaction of the Fish and Game Commission (Commission):

- (A) The permitholder has died, is permanently disabled, or the permitholder is at least 65 years of age and has decided to permanently retire from commercial fishing of all types; and
- (B) California halibut landings contributed significantly to the record and economic income derived from the vessel, to which the CHBTVP is attached, as determined by regulations adopted by the Commission. The Commission may request information that it determines is reasonably necessary from the permitholder or his heirs or estate prior to and for the purposes of authorizing the transfer of the permit.

Permit holder must complete the application and submit the required documentation. Section 8494(d)(3) FGC. See reverse for instructions and documents required for transfer.

California Halibut Bottom Trawl Vessel Permit Transfer Provisions

To maintain eligibility for a CHBTVP that is assigned to a vessel and a vessel owner, the current permit holder must apply and be approved by the Commission for permit transfer prior to the sale of the vessel to maintain the CHBTVP.

INSTRUCTION FOR TRANSFER TO ANOTHER PERSON:

The current permittee must submit documentation to show proof of the facts stated in support of this transfer request with the completed and signed transfer application.

65 Years of age or older

- Completed CHBTVP transfer application.
- If applying for a transfer based on age, a copy of a birth certificate, driver's license, or other documents proving you are at least 65 years of age or older.
- Copy of the permitted vessel's Commercial Boat Registration.
- Copy of the current CHBTVP.
- Copy of the current proof of ownership for the permitted vessel.
- Copies of the permit holder's California Commercial Fishing Permits.
- Copies of fish landing receipts from the boat with the CHBTVP.
- Copy of the proposed permittee's California Commercial Fishing License.

Permanently Disabled

- Completed CHBTVP transfer application.
- If applying for a transfer based on permanent disability, you must provide a copy of a statement from your physician stating that you are permanently disabled from continuing to fish commercially.
- Copy of the permitted vessel's Commercial Boat Registration.
- Copy of the current CHBTVP.
- Copy of the current proof of ownership for the permitted vessel.
- Copies of the permit holder's California commercial fishing permits.
- Copies of fish landing receipts from the boat with the CHBTVP.
- Copy of the proposed permittee's California Commercial Fishing License.

Death of Permit Holder

In the event of the death of the permit holder, the estate of the deceased permit holder should renew the CHBTVP as necessary to keep the permit current until the transfer is approved by the Commission. The estate must submit documentation to show proof of the facts stated in support of this transfer request with the completed transfer application. Suggested supporting documentation include:

Completed CHBTVP transfer application.

- A court document naming the executor/executrix of the estate of the deceased permit holder or other evidence that the person signing the transfer application is an authorized representative of the deceased.
- Copy of the death certificate of the permittee.
- Copy of the deceased's valid CHBTVP and Commercial Boat Registration for the permitted vessel.
- Copy of the current proof of ownership for the permitted vessel.
- Copies of the permit holder's California commercial fishing permits.
- Copies of fish landing receipts from the boat with the CHBTVP.
- Copy of the proposed permittee's California Commercial Fishing License.

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife will review all documentation and submit a request to the Commission to consider at a future Commission meeting. The Commission will notify you of the date when it will consider your request and will notify you by mail of their review of your request.
